Pesticides are an important tool for use in the protection of plants, livestock, fiber, food, human and animal health & structures. A commercial pesticide applicators license grants the licensee the ability to purchase and apply restricted and general use pesticides and receive payment for services. This course is open to anyone 16 years of age or older interested in possessing a commercial pesticide applicators license. The Commercial Pesticide Applicator Course is offered by the University of Wyoming as an agent of the Wyoming Department of Agriculture it is designed to educate potential license holders in the proper handling and use of pesticides and to provide a means for Commercial Applicators to renew or become licensed in the State of Wyoming.
